b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. All members of staff who are authorised to sell alcohol shall be properly trained in the legal requirements and restrictions to sell alcohol;
2. Signs shall be displayed at each point of sale reminding customers it is an offence to purchase or attempt to purchase alcohol by someone aged under 18 years or on behalf of someone aged under 18 years.

c) Public safety

- 3. No smells generated from the cooking processes at the premises shall give rise to nuisance to occupiers of neighbouring properties;
- 4. Rubbish including bottles and / or cans shall not be deposited outside the premises, refuse collections and deliveries shall not take place between 2300 hours and 0700 hours;


